 Erosion & Sediment Control Evaluation from the Soil and Water Conservation District. Exemptions include:  1. Parcels 20 Acres or greater.  2. Sales to an Adjoining Land Owner with Combination
 Fee; only cash or check made payable to the Lorain County Treasurer are accepted (\$40.00 per split; no fee for the remainder or combinations)

- Incomplete applications will not be accepted. Hard copies of all documents and fee must be submitted at the time of application.
